The Port Pirie LGBTIQ+ Community Services Group sought financial support from the Parkstone grant for support in the production of materials to allow the ongoing promotion of the community group.

One of the initiatives of the Port Pirie LGBTIQ Community Group has been to create a sticker (designed by a community member) to be displayed by LGBTIQ+ Friendly businesses, organisations and services in the Port Pirie Region. This has previously been financed by members of the group so it has been welcomed to win the grant.

The LGBTIQ+ Community deserves to feel safe and respected while out and about in our area. The places that display these stickers have been nominated by members of the LGBTIQ+ community due to previous positive experiences. The service provider makes a commitment that their staff and the environment they provide for you to patron will be respectful to members and friends of the LGBTIQ Community. In conjunction with displaying a sticker, the business will be provided with a certificate stating that their space is welcoming, inclusive and free from discrimination.

Representation and visibility are important, and we hope that by seeing the rainbow sticker in our community, with support from business owners and organisations, the LGBTIQ people in our region will know they are safe, accepted and welcome in this space and increase visibility.
